A warm welcome back to you all. The children have settled in well, have made some new friends and have joined in with lots of new and exciting activities. We are very proud of them all! We have also been impressed with the children's independence skills when accessing resources and using the toilet. As the weather is becoming colder, we will be focus on putting our coats on independently. Please support us with this at home.



This term is all about celebrations and stories! We will be celebrating bonfire night, the Hindu festival Diwali, Poppy day, Children in Need and of course Christmas. We will be reading and retelling the following stories; 'Bear Hunt' by Michael Rosen and 'The Stick man' by Julia Donaldson



We will begin our weekly 'Wild walk' this term, along with these circle time sessions;

- 'number time' which will help to develop counting skills and a wider understanding of number
- 'Wiggle and Squiggle' which will encourage the development of large and fine motor skills, preparing little fingers to write
  - daily singing sessions to learn new songs and rhymes.



## Wild Walk

Every Tuesday (Willow class) and every Friday (Cherry class) will go on an adventure around the school grounds, field and woodland track in small groups. The Wild Walk will give us the perfect opportunity to observe nature, wildlife and the changes that occur throughout the seasons. We will go on our Wild walk, whatever the weather, so it is important that the children have access to wet weather gear. Please could you ensure your child has a pair of wellies and an all-in-one splash suit for use in Nursery.

#### **Communication and Language**



The children take part in an 'attention and listening' session each week where we discover something exciting inside a bucket. The children love this activity and their listening and attention skills are continuing to improve as a result.

During small group circle time, we will enjoy a 'Chatterbox session' when the children learn new vocabulary and play fun games to encourage good language and communication skills.


#### **Interactive Learning Diary**
