### **Maths:** (Keep practising times tables up to 12 x 12!)

- The main topics in maths this term are time, statistics and geometry.
- For the week of the term we will be continuing with time.
- Later on in the term, the children will be introduced to statistics and geometry.
- The children will learn how to use their mathematical skills during problem solving activities.

**Reading:** Please can all children continue to read at least five times a week and have their reading journals signed to show this. The children will be rewarded for their progress with their Karate bands when they reach a new milestone. Many of the children have already achieved a black Karate band!
