Dear Parents and Carers,

Although this term is different to usual, we would like to start by saying 'Well done!' for all the amazing home learning you have already done. It is fantastic to see all your work, as well as all the other activities you are completing at home.

English

- In phonics this term, the children will be revisiting and consolidating their knowledge of Phase 5 and Phase 3 from Letters and Sounds. There will be a focus on reading real and alien words.
- Please continue reading with your children at home 5 times in the week to ensure they are working towards earning their next Reading Karate band. Please make use of Bug Club and Oxford Owl, as we are currently unable to send physical books home.
- In our English lessons, we will be focusing on the book 'The Gingerbread Man'. This will follow the structure of Pie Corbitt, which involves learning the story, re-telling the story and re-inventing the story. We will also use 'The Gingerbread Man' to teach skills such as nouns and adjectives.

Maths

In mathematics, we will be learning about:

- Addition and Subtraction, including - finding a part, counting forwards and back, finding the difference, number bonds to 20.
- Money - recognising money and using money to count in 2s and 5s
- Time - introducing time-related language, sequence events and learning to tell o'clock and half past.

PE

As we are at home, it is important to keep active.

Each week we will post a different P.E activity such as circuits, dance or yoga. Don't forget Joe Wicks posts live PE sessions every Monday, Wednesday and Friday if you wanted to give those a go!

Topic











- In Science, we are going to be learning about the different materials and carrying out experiments and observations.
