Dear Parents and Carers,

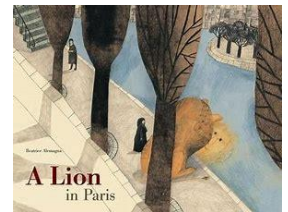
Welcome to the final term of Year 1 - we can't believe how quick this year has flown by! We are looking forward to making lots of amazing memories as we complete this year.

Phonics

- In Phonics this term children will continue to work in groups at their challenge level to provide targeted support for any sounds they need to work on. This phonics will now include an additional reading section and you will be provided with books that your child has been working on in school (more info to follow).

English

- Our new text focus will be 'A Lion in Paris'. Following the fictional story on how The Lion of Belfort statue came to be in Paris.
- We will be focusing on many different skills this term including; fictional writing, using plurals nouns and editing our own work.
- This book ties in beautifully with our Humanities work.



Maths

- In mathematics we will be focusing on:
 - Place Value - counting backwards within 100 and representing numbers using base tens.
 - Money - recognising coins and notes, counting/making amounts and comparing amounts of money.
 - Time - telling the time to o'clock and half past.
 - Consolidation of skills this year including - numbers bonds, halving and doubling.

Topic

- Science - we are going to be looking at properties of materials, grouping and comparing them.
- In Humanities we will be learning about the landmarks in Paris and Bristol and the famous engineers behind them with a focus on Brunel. We will be visiting the SS Great Britain to support our learning.
- RE - we will be focusing on Judaism this term and learning all about Yom Kippur.
- PSHE - we will be looking at the topic of 'changing me' and thinking about how we grown and change.
- PE - in both indoor and outdoor PE we will be focusing on hitting and catching skills. We will also be participating in a school sports day.
